



### COVID-19 Outbreak Dashboard

To protect the health of our school community, Trinity Lutheran will provide Public Notice to our School community regarding School Associated Cases of COVID-19.

When Trinity receives notification of a positive case, we contract trace and notify families of possible exposure.

This dashboard includes ONLY confirmed COVID-19 cases among students, staff, administration, coaches, or any other person who was present on school property or at a school function under circumstances that may result in the transmission of COVID-19 during their infectious period.

This dashboard will be updated to include new and cumulative COVID-19 case counts as they occur.
